SPL raise: Jump 1-level higher than an F1/FG bid;

RKCB(4NT) 1430 with TQA(Trump Q Ask), SKA(Specific K Ask), 2KA(2nd K Ask), 3CA(3rd Control Ask) and void answers 5N(Even Kc w/useful void)/6x(Odd Kc w/x-void)/6T(Odd Kc w/higher void); DOPI/DEPO and ROPI;

XRKC=When Trump is agreed or implied: [a] SPL+jump 1 level; [b] j/jj-newsuit above 4N[RKCB]/4m[RKCm]

GSF=5NT when bypassing 4NT

Gerber: A-Ask when 4C over 1NT or 2NT opening, response, rebid, or as defined in 1N/2N or 2C-2D; 2NT System-On sequences. Also Super Gerber: 5C over NAT 3NT bid.

Gerber after fit found=RKC Gerber
